VISION

Enlightened and prospering Punjab through equitable opportunity for quality education.

POLICY

- > Ensure achievement of all education related Millennium Development Goals by 2015:
 - Universal Primary Education
 - Completion of full Primary Schooling by all children
 - Promote Gender Equality and empower women
 - Eliminate Regional disparity.
- > Ensure 100% participation rate at primary level by 2015 and participation enhancement at the elementary & secondary level;
- Improving quality of education;
- > Promote science & computer education at the secondary & tertiary level;
- > Reduction in gender and regional disparity in access to education;
- > Revamp college education by developing strong relationship between tertiary education and the job market;
- Make tertiary education institutions autonomous financially, administratively as well as in academic terms;
- > To reach out for the following goals:
 - Expand early childhood care and education, Universal Primary Education by 2015:
 - Equitable access to learning and life skills;
 - Gender equality by 2015.

The Education development program includes a reform agenda based on the following parallel but mutually supportive axis:

- Reformed institutions
- Reformed service structures

- Development & embedding of information / decision support systems
- Provision of an enabling environment for reforms
- Invoking an international cultural shift within the School Education Department

New business processes have been introduced in the last four years in following institutions:-

- Directorate of Staff Development is training teachers by in-sourcing and out-sourcing to the private sector
- Punjab Text Book Board is shifting from in-house publication and printing of books to outsourcing
- **Punjab Education Foundation** has been given under private sector led management through a new legal framework. It is now partnering with low cost private schools for performance based fee subsidization. It is also developing an education voucher scheme for Foundation Assisted Schools (FAS) located in urban slums of 15 less-developed districts in Punjab.
- School Councils have been set up with more than 50% representation of parents in all government schools in the province. These are empowered and authorized to spend up to Rs.400, 000 per annum for improvement of school including hiring of substitute teachers, through amendments in business processes. Reactivation of school councils is a major initiative of School Education Department and more than Rs.500 million have been utilized to rejuvenate these councils. Development NGOs (NRSP and PRSP) have been engaged for capacity building of school councils in 6 pilot districts of Punjab. This year it is proposed to extend the programme to non-pilot districts.
- Punjab Examination Commission (PEC) has been established to monitor students performance over time through administering and yearly standardized test in all subjects to more than 2 million students studying in grade five & eight in both public as well as private schools. This will help in performance, monitoring and evaluation of each of the institution.
- Provincial Education Reform Commission A Provincial Education Reform Commission is being set up with a total cost of Rs.10 million. It would act as a centre of excellence to achieve the desired objective of model schools philosophy. Initially, 144 high schools would be converted into Model Schools including dormitories for vulnerable groups in 72 schools. This facility would be later extended to whole of Punjab to ensure that each Tehsil has a share of two such model educational institutions. The gender equity will be ensured by providing such facility at 1:1 ratio.

REFORMED SERVICES STRUCTURES

Some of the major changes introduced for improvement of service structures are :

- **Better Qualified Teachers:** keeping in view the international best practices, the province has also adopted facility based contract employment and has also up scaled minimum qualification for a primary school teacher to BA/B.Ed. More than 50,000 teachers have been recruited on these terms in the last four years.
- Introduction of an Independent Field Inspection Tier: Vast improvements in monitoring regime in the sector have earned laurels for the department. Nine hundred mobile monitors have been employed on contract basis to monitor 63,000 schools

• Restructuring of the District Management Tier: To organize the department on functional lines for purposes of efficiency and efficacy, posts of DEO (F&P/DEO HR & Monitoring) and DEO (Teacher Training & Student Assessment) have been introduced. This has helped avoid duplication of effort and fragment planning. Their capacity building is in progress.

DEVELOPMENT OF INFORMATION & DECISION SUPPORT SYSTEM

Punjab has made substantial headway in developing real time management information system to support the decision-making processes and help in implementing evidence based planning. Fully networked IT based system comprises complete human resource and institution database of the public sector education system. Necessary protocols have been implemented to keep the database current and data integrity is regularly checked through reputable third party firms, such as M/S Ferguson, Price Waterhouse etc.

ENABLING ENVIRONMENT FOR REFORMS

Strong and consistent political and bureaucratic leadership is the most critical factor in successful implementation of education sector reforms. Active support and guidance from the Steering Committee has provided to the leadership to the reform effort. It also insulates the reform effort from all external pressures. Strong commitment from international development partners, such as the World Bank is evident in their on-going support.

CULTURAL SHIFT

Invoking a deliberate cultural shift within the education department was a part of the reform design itself. Three years down the road and with the help of modern planning and information tools, this shift has become visible in the following ways:-

- A marked departure from fundamental conservatism and clinging to outworn tradition
- Curbed tendency to ignore or reject information especially when it tends to return the user to a previous level of uncertainty
- Curbed tendency to under -or -over estimate the difficulty of tasks or base planning on anecdotal evidence
- A lesser degree of indecisiveness
- Slightly less aversion to take risks as they are to be managed and not avoided

NEW INITIATIVES

MODEL SCHOOLS PROGRAMME INCLUDING DORMITORIES FOR VULNERABLE GROUPS

Quality education is high priority area of the Government and, therefore, it has been decided to set up model schools in public sector institutions which would be a centre of excellence as a roadmap for this goal. To achieve this objective, initially, 144 schools will be converted into model schools, out of which 72 schools would be provided with dormitories for vulnerable groups during FY 2008-09 at total cost of Rs.3630 million. Major components of a Model School include (a) Infrastructure facilities (b) Science Labs (c) I.T Labs (d) Libraries and (e) Dormitories for vulnerable groups.

PROVISION OF COMPUTER / I.T EDUCATION IN SECONDARY AND HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOLS

In order to better equip the students with I.T. learning and technological transformation, it has been proposed through this scheme to spread I.T. education at secondary and higher secondary level and to create opportunities for I.T. educated personnel. Total cost of the scheme is Rs.4929.000 million. Target of the scheme is establishment of I.T. Labs in 4574 secondary and higher secondary schools alongwith provision of I.T. Labs staff (one I.T. teacher, one Lab attendant), all over the Punjab.

EDUCATION PRIORITY PROGRAMME

To meet the demand for up-gradation of schools from Primary to Middle, Middle to High, High to Higher Secondary School, especially for such areas where there is a genuine need on merit, Education Department decided to continue Education Department's priority programme with an allocation of Rs. 1000 million during 2008-09.

ACCELERATED PROGRAMME FOR SCHOOLS EDUCATION

- Education is an inherent right of all children. For providing quality education to all different interventions like capacity building of teachers and education managers continue assessment of learning achievement through examinations, provision of quality text books, I.T labs and libraries have already been introduced. To achieve this objective, up-gradation of girls schools in general and up-gradation of girls schools from Middle to High, in particular, will be the target areas during CFY 2008-09.
- 560 girls and 542 boys schools will be up-graded.
